- There were some questions about "purchased services;"
- There are approximately sixty out-of-county students and some are children of teachers and the cost to Lancaster County taxpayers is about \$300,000; and
- Increase starting salary to \$33,000 for teachers, which is an increase of approximately 3.89%.

The school board members need copies of the audit.

The school board needs to get fuel contracts, so they do not overspend.
