A FY 2018 Budget Work Session of the Lancaster County Board of Supervisors was held in the Administrative Building Board/Commission Meeting Room of said county on Thursday, May 25, 2017.

Mr. Lee called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

BUDGET CONSIDERATION

Mr. Lee asked Bonnie Dickson to give an update on the budget expenditures and revenues since the last work session.

Ms. Dickson stated that the budget packets she just gave the Board included the FY 17 expenditures through the end of May. She referred to the revenues for the general fund only, excluding social services and the schools, and stated that the amount is on target at just above \$21 million dollars for what was anticipated receiving this year. She stated that the expenditures for the general fund, excluding social services and the schools, were at \$19 million dollars, which leaves twenty-five percent still remaining of what was budgeted and appropriated. She stated that the County has underspent, but there are still June expenses to consider.

Mr. Pleva asked about the debt service payments.

Ms. Dickson stated that the debt service payments are paid in January and July and that is included in the budget numbers.

Ms. Dickson referred to the figure of \$2,118,707 on the budget synopsis and stated that was the total for requested expenditures for FY 18 in excess of expected revenues for FY 18.

Mr. Lee asked how much the tax rate would have to be in order to not decrease the fund balance and not cut the budget.

Ms. Dickson replied that if everything in the budget were left as is, it would translate to approximately a 8 ¼ cents tax increase without decreasing the fund balance.

CLOSED MEETING

Motion was made by Mr. Lee to enter into closed meeting to discuss matters exempt from the open meeting requirements of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act. The subject matter to be discussed in the closed meeting is Personnel Matters, δ 2.2-3711.A.1 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended. The purpose of the closed meeting is for discussion and consideration of salaries (compensation) of specific officers and employees of the public governing body.
