Jimmy Dall, residing on Waverly Avenue, said he was concerned about past failures at the sewage treatment plant. Members of the Town Council were not aware of any past failures of the sewage treatment plant.

Bob Miller said he was concerned about rain overflowing into sewage treatment tanks. Council member commented that this has never happened and the system is designed to control storm water.

Anne Deutch, residing on Oak Lane, had concerns about the temperature and/or oxygen changes in Boat House Cove.
