

LANCASTER COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION MEETING

February 26, 2019

The Electoral Board met at the office of the General Registrar at the request of the General Registrar to discuss recent pending General Assembly Early Voting law(s). In attendance were Chairman Barbara Breeden, Vice-Chair Robert Bennett, Secretary Lee Pulling and General Registrar Susan Jett. Barbara Breeden called the meeting to order at 1:10pm.

It appears that the 2019 General Assembly is likely to produce an early voting bill. The resources we would need to accommodate early voting require immediate planning and action. The North Carolina voting procedure for early and absentee voting was reviewed and discussed extensively as a comparison to the voter numbers in Lancaster County.

It was agreed that members would contact present precinct sites to establish satellite offices and vacant spaces for rent to handle the large increase in voter turnout prior to election day and report back to the General Registrar their findings.

A motion was made by Robert Bennett to adjourn at 2:25pm and seconded by Barbara Breeden.
